- 2009 Sauvignon Blanc, Dog Point, New Zealand 11 / 44  
 ♦ *Seriously good wine, intense & elegantly textural example with its guava fruit, hints of basil & silky citrus mineral spine. Pucker up, it's a grapefruit in a glass!*
- 2009 Pinot Grigio, The Killer, Veneto, Italy 10 / 40  
 ♦ *Sophisticated, sexy & stylish...one taste & you will be captivated. Light floral & fruit with a crisp racy finish.*
- 2007 Gewürztraminer, Washington Hills, Washington State 8 / 32  
 ♦ *Fragrant notes of lychee, cloves, bright pineapple & spice with balanced acidity, capturing this generous varietals' essence.*
- 2010 Cocktail of Grapes, Bartier Scholefield, Okanagan, Canada 11 / 44  
 ♦ *A refreshing blend of Pinot Gris, Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Blanc & Chardonnay. This wine is a true expression of fruit with non-interventionist techniques. No barrels used, lees contact significant which contributes to mid-palate strength.*
- 2008 'Singing' Grüner Veltliner, Laurenz V, Austria 10 / 40  
 ♦ *Dedicated to Laurenz's daughter who wants to become the next generation winemaker. Harmonious fruit & refreshing finish. Super stylish, tell them in New York you tasted this in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan!*
- 2009 Malvar, Zestos Blanco, Arganda - Spain 10 / 40  
 ♦ *The Malvar grape varietal is indigenous to the Madrid region of Spain. Tropical fruit flavours backed by citrus notes, a brisk minerality adds interest and complexity. Think Viognier meets Sancerre. Limited availability.*
- 2008 Chardonnay, Catena, Argentina 10 / 40  
 ♦ *Fresh aromas of stone & citrus fruits, with hints of lees & spices. A creamy textured vibrant wine. Nicolas Catena, 2009 Decanter man of the year. 90 pts Wine access, 91 pts Wine Advocate.*
- 2008 Petit Verdot, Ruca Malen, Reserva, Mendoza, Argentina 10 / 40  
 ♦ *Displays intense red fruit, reminiscent of plums & cherries combined with subtle floral accents & sweet spices. Recommended with roast meats, ripe cheese, but lovely on its own.*
- 2010 Malbec, Domaine Jean Bousquet, Argentina 10 / 40  
 ♦ *Hand harvested. Dry with flavours of black cherry, licorice & hinting at vanilla. Certified ORGANIC. Gold Medal MondusVini.*
- 2006 Southbrook 'Triomphe', Niagara Peninsula, Ontario 12 / 48  
 ♦ *Aromas of blackcurrant & cedar, flavours of raspberry, cassis & fresh herbs. Long finish, medium-bodied. Winemaker Ann Sperling, arguably one of Canada's finest winemakers. Limited availability, organic/ biodynamic production. Gold Level LEED.*
- 2010 Cabernet/Shiraz, Passion Has Red Lips, Some Young Punks, Australia 12 / 48  
 ♦ *Complex aromas of vivid red & dark berries, pungent herbs & fresh flowers. Round & seductive, like your woman. No intrusive tannins to get in the way of the fruit. 90 pts Wine Spectator.*
- 2006 Tempranillo, Sabor Real, Spain 9 / 36  
 ♦ *Made in Northwest Spain (Toro region), this wine is dark fruit driven, with plenty of structure, a roasted perfume & a spicy finish. We agree with Robert Parker, this dark beauty is sure to please.*
- 2009 Pinot Noir, Quinta Clava, Casablanca Valley, Chile 9 / 36  
 ♦ *100% Pinot Noir. Earthy, juicy with an elegant long smooth finish. Burgundian fans will delight in this well made affordable gem. Heart break grape hits all the right notes with this one.*
- 2008 Alma Negra, Mendoza, Argentina 11 / 44  
 ♦ *An intriguing blend of Bonarda & Malbec. This house favourite, the "dark soul", will hopefully be here in time for Halloween!*
