- ◆ *Seriously good wine, intense & elegantly textural example with its guava fruit, hints of basil & silky citrus mineral spine. Pucker up, it's a grapefruit in a glass!*
- 2007 Bantam, Red Rooster, Okanagan, BC 8 / 32
- ◆ *Auxerrois, blended with Chardonnay & Pinot Grigio. A nice everyday sipper. Silver Medal - Los Angeles International wine competition.*
- 2008 Chenin Blanc, The Winery of Good Hope, South Africa 10 / 40
- ◆ *This top producer has delivered a delicious example of a dry Chenin Blanc complete with flavours of pear & white currants rounded out with a touch of mint.*
- 2008 Mandrarossa Fiano, Settesoli & MandmaRossa, Sicily 10 / 40
